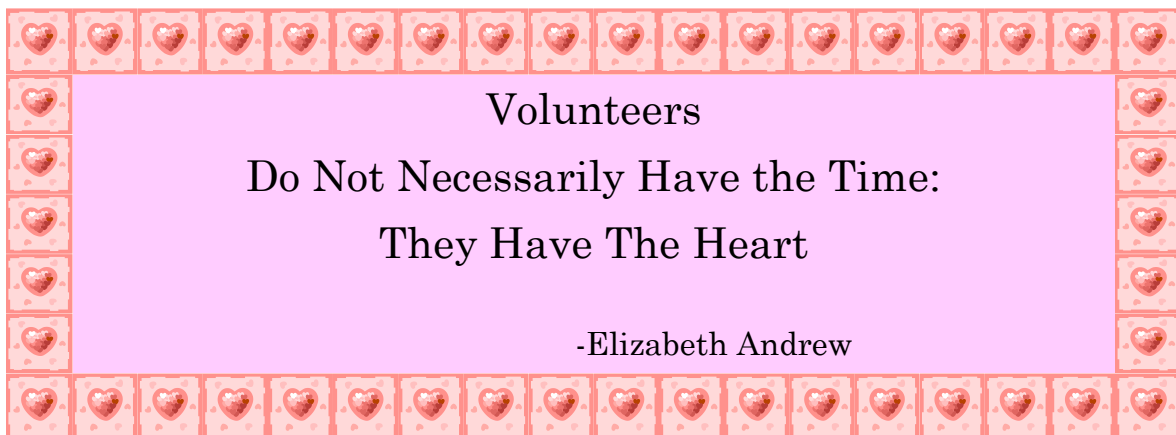
**MILITARY COMMITTEE**
