I never had the pleasure of meeting him, yet I was shaken by the impact of his passing. He was just a kid doing what kids do.

So why is this tragedy part of my president's message? Because I always say the VTWC is a giving club that responds when people are in need. But this month our entire community became a giving club. The day after his passing, students and faculty at SIX different schools honored him by wearing white. A GoFundMe page raised over \$40,000 in four days. Eight local restaurants and businesses hosted fundraisers for his family and donated enormous amounts of food for the repast.
